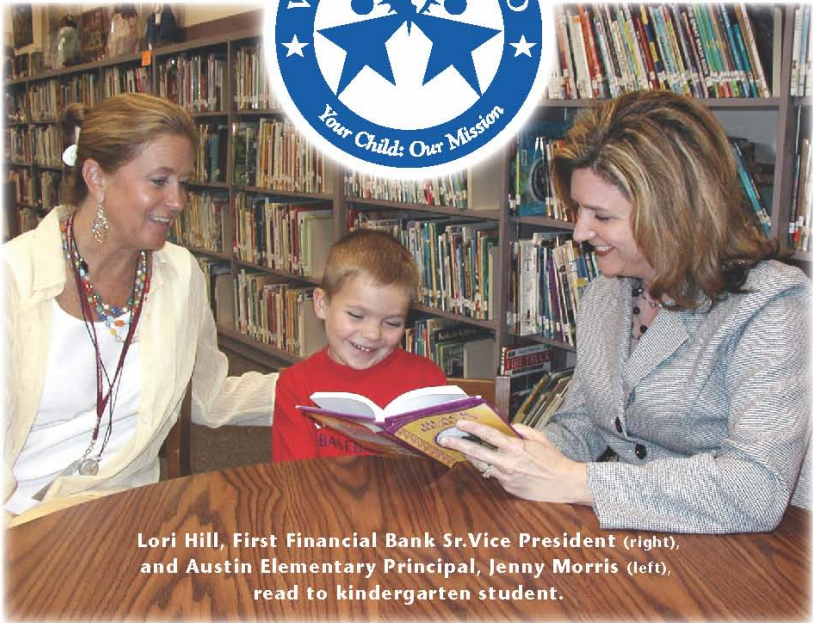
- You may skip ahead to the bid amount you wish to pay. The next bidder must bid higher than your bid to be successful.
