- District Goal: We will inspire all of our students to be actively involved in the learning process through a challenging curriculum.
- Campus Goal: Increase academic achievement in Reading, Writing, Math, Science, and Social Studies for all students.
- Target Objectives:
- 1.1 100% of students in grades K-2 will demonstrate mastery of grade level reading skills as measured by TPRI and DRA.
  - 1.2 100% of students in grades K-2 will demonstrate mastery of grade level math skills as measured by AMI assessments.
  - 1.3 100% of students in grades 3-6 will pass the Reading, Writing, Math, and Science TAKS.
  - 1.4 100% of Special Education students in grades 3-6 will pass TAKS Reading, Writing, Math, and Science or will exhibit at least one year's growth on the SDAA for Reading, Writing, and Math.
  - 1.5 Increase the percentage of students in grades 3-6 who receive commended status on the TAKS test.
  - 1.6 100% of students in grades K-6 will write on a daily basis.
  - 1.7 100% of teachers will be trained in the New Jersey Writing Project.
  - 1.8 100% of students will be provided with social studies instruction based on the district scope and sequence, which is aligned to the skills tested on the 8<sup>th</sup> grade social studies TAKS.
  - 1.9 100% of students will provided with science instruction based on the district scope and sequence, which is aligned to the skills tested on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade science TAKS.
